Early Learners (under 7)

Special Times – By Betty Jo Middleton

This year long program explores the richness of our Jewish and Christian heritages by celebrating holidays and other special times we set apart for worship and ceremony. It is packed full of activities and covers 26 weeks of material.

Elementarily Learners (7 to 12)

The Life and Teachings of Jesus - By Donna Wheelock and Judith Hoehler

Explores the events of Jesus's life, his teachings, and the customs of the times it offers opportunities for discussion, activities for enrichment, and celebrations.

The curriculum includes varied activities such as drama, word games, craft projects, and cooking ideas it also provides opportunities to discuss the birth stories, miracles, and the resurrection.

Lessons 23 and 24 offer a specifically Unitarian Universalist approach to the resurrection stories. The program implicitly affirms these UU Principles and source: a free and responsible search for truth and meaning; the inherent worth and dignity of every person; the goal of world community with peace, liberty, and justice for all; experiences of transcending mystery and wonder; and acceptance of one another and encouragement to spiritual growth in our congregations.
